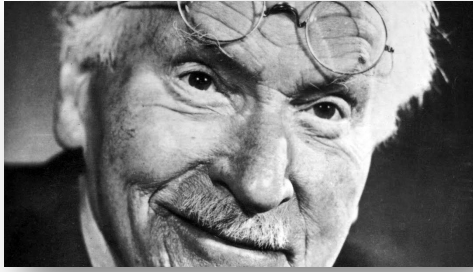

URSULA WIRTZ, PhD, was born in Germany and received her doctorate in philosophy and literature from the University of Munich (1971) and her degree as a clinical and anthropological psychologist from the University of Zürich (1982). She is a Jungian training analyst with a diploma from the C. G. Jung Institute Zürich (1982). She has taught at various European universities and lectured also in Canada, the United States, South Africa, China, and Taiwan. She is also the author of numerous publications on trauma, ethics, and spirituality. Her book *Trauma and Beyond: The Mystery of Transformation* was published in English by Spring Journal Books in 2014.

Ursula loves traveling and working with different cultural backgrounds. She has been involved in the training of developing Jungian groups in Eastern Europe (Moscow, Lithuania, Estonia, and Czech Republic) and served as a member of the ethics committee of the IAAP and the Swiss umbrella association of all psychotherapeutic schools. She also has extensive experience as a team supervisor in a wide variety of institutions that work with trauma survivors (women's shelters, counseling centers for survivors of sexual abuse and the Holocaust, and the Swiss Red Cross Outpatient Clinic for the Victims of Torture and War).

Ursula is passionate about riding horses and loves the desert and sailing in the Mediterranean Sea. Together with Jürg, her "beloved" of thirty-five years, a Neo-Freudian psychoanalyst, she works as an analyst in private practice in Zürich.
